She completed her pre-doctoral internship at the Semel Institute for Neuroscience and Human Behavior at the University of California-Los Angeles; and her post-doctoral fellowship in pediatric neuropsychology at the University of Minnesota-Twin Cities.

Rex Lott, PharmD, BCPP is a Professor of Pharmacy Practice with Idaho State University College of Pharmacy with practice, teaching, and research activities at Boise VA Medical Center in Boise. He provides consultation regarding pharmacotherapy of psychiatric and neurologic disorders to staff and patients of BVAMC, teaches Doctor of Pharmacy students, PGY1 Pharmacy Residents, PGY2 Psychiatric Pharmacy Residents, and PGY2 & PGY3 Psychiatry Residents.

Kavita Patil MS, OTR/L is a pediatric occupational therapist who specializes in Autism, Sensory Integration, Self-Regulation deficits, and early childhood development at St. Luke's Children's Rehab in Meridian Idaho. Kavita is currently undergoing certification in Early Start Denver Model an evidence based treatment program for young kids with Autism. In addition to her clinical practice, Kavita also manages the St. Luke's Children's Rehab Clinic in Meridian.

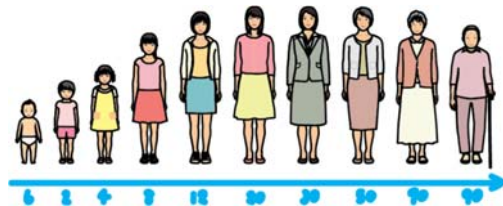
